American Society for Healthcare Engineering Education Programs – FREE!

Healthcare construction is in high demand in New Jersey and the Northeast. According to the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, the healthcare industry has grown rapidly since 2011 and will continue to grow. Increasingly, hospital and healthcare facility owners require professional recognition from contractors for them to be able to perform work in healthcare facilities. The American Society for Healthcare Engineering (ASHE) provides exactly those credentials, making the contractors more competitive in the industry.
