





# Labor

Twenty-two apprentices from International Union of Operation Engineers, Local 825's 2022 Earn and Learn apprenticeship class were beaming as they walked across the stage at the Red Bull Arena in Harrison, NJ as part of the Hudson County Community College 2024 Commencement exercises. Family, friends, and colleagues cheered from the crowded stands, and HCCC President Dr. Reber called out their achievement as the beginning of a new era of partnerships between labor and education. The students earned 30 credits for their apprenticeship, and took an additional thirty credits of online classes in order to receive their Associate of Applied Science degree in Technical Studies. Some students are already planning to continue on to a bachelor's degree. The Earn and Learn program exists partially thanks to a generous NJ PLACE 2.0 grant, which funded tuition and other related expenses. Students in the program paid nothing for their degrees, and completed the program concurrently with their apprenticeship requirements.
