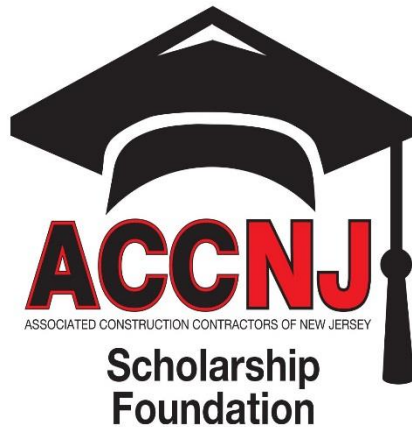

About the ACCNJ Scholarship Foundation...

Each year, the Associated Construction Contractors of New Jersey Scholarship Foundation provides scholarship awards to children and grandchildren of members' employees to assist with their higher education needs. This year, the Foundation will offer five \$12,500 scholarship opportunities for eligible high school graduates pursuing undergraduate degrees.

In addition, the Foundation offers a \$10,000 John F. Donohoe Scholarship for civil engineering students already enrolled in an accredited civil engineering program.

2019 ACCNJ Foundation Scholarships

High School Graduates

The following 2019 scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors entering an accredited college or university as full-time students, pursuing their undergraduate degrees with a minimum of 12 credits per semester, beginning in September 2019.

The Peter E. Davis Memorial Scholarship (\$12,500)

The Michael J. Paquet Memorial Scholarship (\$12,500)

The Michael McHugh Memorial Scholarship (\$12,500)

ACCNJ Foundation Scholarship (\$12,500)

Candidates will be evaluated on character, academic performance, extracurricular activities and community service. The top five candidates will receive scholarship awards.

Civil Engineering Students

The John F. Donohoe Scholarship is available to current civil engineering students entering the second, third or fourth year of an accredited civil engineering program beginning in September 2019.

John F. Donohoe Civil Engineering Scholarship (\$10,000)

Award Notifications

Successful candidates will be notified by May 16, 2019, and should plan to attend the ACCNJ Scholarship Dinner on June 5, 2019, at Mayfair Farms in West Orange to receive their awards.

Employee Eligibility Requirements

- *Employee must have worked for an ACCNJ member company domiciled in New Jersey for at least 1,000 hours between March 1, 2018 and March 1, 2019.*

ACCNJ Foundation Scholarship Submittal Requirements (High School)

- *Participation Intent Form*
- *Applicant Information (Only one completed application is necessary for consideration for all scholarships awarded to high school students)*
- *Employee Information/Verification Form*
- *Official High School Transcript*
- *Official SAT or ACT scores (if not displayed on transcript)*
- *Two letters of reference (one reference from a current faculty member on school letterhead)*
- *Essay (a brief essay about yourself, including any relevant circumstances in your life of which you believe the review committee should be aware)*
- *List of Activities, Volunteer and/or Community Service, Employment*

John F. Donohoe Scholarship Submittal Requirements

- *Applicant Information*
- *Official College Transcript*
- *Official High School Transcript (only required for civil engineering students entering their sophomore year in 2019)*
- *Official SAT or ACT scores*
- *Two letters of reference (one reference from a current faculty member on school letterhead)*
- *Essay (see application for details)*
