

Which of your projects were shut down due to the Governor Murphy's Executive Order in New Jersey and/or per the Owner's direction?


NUMBER OF PROJECTS SHUT DOWN AS REPORTED BY SURVEY RESPONDENTS

Number of Craftworkers Laid Off as Reported by Survey Respondents




The most layoffs reported were laborers, followed by operators, followed by carpenters.

PERCENTAGE OF RESPONDENTS REPORTING DIFFICULTY WITH WORKFORCE AVAILABILITY



Are you experiencing slower than normal payments from owners and/or general contractors?



■ On Time Payments ■ Somewhat Slower than Normal ■ Much Slower than Normal




What is the number of “essential” projects where construction schedules may now be delayed due to lack of productivity or workforce issues?

How many office employees have you laid off or furloughed due to projects shutting down?


Number of Office Employees Laid Off or Furloughed as Reported by Respondents



Have you had any craftworkers that contracted COVID 19?


PERCENTAGE OF RESPONDENTS WITH EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE CONTRACTED COVID-19

■ No Craftworkers Have Contracted COVID-19 ■ One or More Craftworkers Have Contracted COVID-19




Are you currently paying craftworkers under the FFCRA for Paid Sick Leave or Extended Family Medical Leave? Please check all that apply.


Bids Submitted for Future Projects Since April 1, 2020, as Reported by Survey Respondents



Have you been notified of any project cancellations previously bid but not yet started?



Are you currently experiencing any project delays or disruptions due to the following? Please check all that apply.


Number of Respondents Experiencing Project Delays or Disruptions Due to the Following


