COVID-19 Updates

Federal Contractor Mandate Temporarily Blocked by Federal Court

In an ACCNJ Alert distributed on December 9, we informed members President Biden's COVID-19 vaccination mandate for federal contractors has been blocked by a preliminary injunction issued by a U.S. District Court in Georgia. The injunction applies nationwide and prevents federal agencies from enforcing the mandate while the litigation continues. Substantive issues concerning the legality of President Biden's executive order still need to be decided.

Appellate Court Lifts Stay on OSHA ETS

In an ACCNJ Alert distributed on December 20, we notified members the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit dissolved the Fifth Circuit's stay of OSHA's Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) for employers with 100 or more employees. OSHA is now allowed to proceed with the implementation and enforcement of the rule originally issued on November 5, 2021. In an ACCNJ Safety Email, we informed members of a new decision by the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission (OSHRC), which holds that road construction companies must adopt fall-protection measures for employees working from the backs of moving vehicles, but the panel took no clear position on what abatement methods the employers must use.
