Bargaining Rights Authorization Form --

Laborers Local Union Nos. 172 & 472 and Asphalt Laborers Local No. 172

In Bulletin 68-2023, we informed Active Members the collective bargaining agreements between the Associated Construction Contractors of New Jersey and Laborers, Local Union Nos. 172 and 472, and Asphalt Laborers Local No. 172 expires on February 29, 2024. Increase in New Jersey Construction Spending

In an [ACCNJ Alert](#) distributed on September 11, 2023, we informed members Governor Murphy announced an additional \$875 million in spending for New Jersey construction projects. The funds will be administered to the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT), NJ TRANSIT, and the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (NJSDA).
